Horses Lead Courses – Inspiring Leaders

Why this course

When we are in a position of leadership there are textbooks on, and examples of, good leadership to help. However putting that knowledge into practice can be tricky. Getting clear, honest, helpful and immediate feedback from people about how they experience our leadership skills can be a challenge. Horses on the other hand don't read textbooks and their responses are not conditioned by the complexities underlying human interactions. In the wild their lives would depend on recognising a good leader and behaving as part of that leader's team (herd) which makes them a discerning mirror for any would be human leader.
